



Large Standing Buddha In Gilded Wood



Description

High gilded wooden statue of Thai origin that will always be benevolent in your home. This sculpture adorned with rhinestones throughout its clothes is accompanied by an authorized export certificate from the Ministry of Thailand, which does not attest to its age. This Buddha is standing, in the samabhanga position, on a round pedestal in the shape of a lotus leaf, in the mudra of charity or varada. Both hands lowered: this mudra (positioning) advocates charity, compassion and the fulfillment of wishes. It symbolizes the five perfections: generosity, morality, patience, effort and meditative concentration, through the five outstretched fingers. And I will not tell you more... It is up to you to talk to him.
