



A Beggar - Maurice Maignan - Bronze



Description

Bronze statuette representing a man sitting on a bench, his head covered with a worker's cap, resting on the back, his hands buried in his pockets. The man seems overwhelmed by the cold.

This work, entitled "Un Gueux", was created by the sculptor Maurice Maignan. It was presented at the Salon de la Société Nationale des Beaux-Arts in 1897. Published in bronze by Alexis Rudier, it was very successful at the end of the 19th century and the beginning of the 20th century.

An identical copy of this sculpture is kept at the Musée d'Orsay under the inventory number RF4677.
