



Pair Of 18th Century Officer's Pistols

Description

Long pair pommel pistols from the early 18th century, circa 1730.

Round barrels with a top face, slightly blunderbussed at the muzzle, profusely engraved with hollow-bottomed foliage and thunderbolts.

Gilded breech tails forming a rise. Gilded sights.

Muzzles decorated with volutes.

Gilded flintlocks engraved with hollow-bottomed animals and figures. Gilded faceted bassinets and spark arresters. Burnished steel batteries and hammers engraved with hollow-bottomed volutes.

Blond walnut mounts, with long barrels, carved around all the recesses. Gilded caps with long ears engraved with hollow-bottomed faces and volutes. Cap screws hidden by a button in the shape of a lion's muzzle. Openwork counterplate.
