Description

This pair of printed cotton curtains is part of the French decorative tradition, directly inspired by the famous toiles de Jouy. Measuring 305 cm in height (with 12 cm reserve in the hem) and 142 cm in width, these curtains are elegantly edged with a blue braid, providing a neat and refined finish. They have a gathering ribbon allowing a harmonious fall, as well as hooks with wooden rings to facilitate their suspension on a rod. Toiles de Jouy refer to the famous printed fabrics created in the 18th century in the Jouy-en-Josas factory (near Versailles). They are characterized by monochrome patterns on a light background, often in blue, red or gray, representing bucolic, mythological or historical scenes. Historical context: Invented in 1760 by Christophe-Philippe Oberkampf, toile de Jouy was an immediate

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success in Europe, particularly in aristocratic and bourgeois interiors. It symbolizes French elegance and remains a timeless reference in the field of interior decoration.

Modern Renaissance: Since the 19th century, toile de Jouy patterns have been regularly reinterpreted to meet contemporary decorative trends.

Patterns: The prints evoke rustic and romantic scenes typical of toile de Jouy. These patterns are inspired by engravings and offer remarkable finesse of detail.

Layout: The pair of curtains is designed to dress high windows or large openings, creating a majestic effect.

Blue braid: The braid brings a touch of contrast that highlights the printed patterns and reinforces the classic elegance of the whole.

Light background: The neutral background, often white or ecru, is an essential characteristic of toile de Jouy. It highlights printed patterns.

Blue: Blue is an emblematic color of toiles de Jouy. It symbolizes serenity, refinement and goes harmoniously with classic or modern interiors.

Blue braid: It provides a subtle and elegant decorative frame.
