Community or chapel bell in bronze*, decorated with a cross of Lorraine or Anjou with a clover in the upper part, wrought iron handle, from the 16th-17th centuries. This bell is in good general condition, it is in its original condition. It rings very well despite the holes present. Please note: traces of oxidation on the iron, accidents and holes on the bell, wear and tear, see photos. * Bronze (from the Latin aes) is a term synonymous with bronze (alloy of copper and tin) used in certain contexts.
