Very beautiful dagger with flamboyant blade with fillet and gilded decoration of companionship or freemason attributes, 19th century. Beautiful straight blade of 21 cm with ricasso of 5 cm with decoration, bloody heart pierced by 2 arrows and wings and on the other side several tools. Part of the blade with flamboyance of 12 cm ending in a point on a diamond-shaped blade with central median ridge, gilded cutting edge. Brown horn fuse and metal pommel with rivet button. Straight quillon ending in the shape of a heart. Scarlet blade tie present. Leather scabbard with 2 decoration and monogram and symbols. On the fleur-de-lys chape and on the other side "X".
