Pocket watch or pocket watch with a soap dish by Just in solid silver with niello decoration with a vertical straight line and an oval-shaped shield with no initials on the watch cover. - Opening of the pocket watch cover by pressing the button located on the top of the winding crown. - French hallmark of crab title 800/1000 in use in France from 1838 to 1962 with the difference of the Besançon precious metals control office between the lower legs of the crab present on the edge of the watch case, dust cover, bail and head of the pendant. - Diamond-shaped goldsmith's hallmark present on the dust cover with a rooster and the letters .GG on either side of the rooster and the number 748082 engraved in hollow on the dust cover. - Smooth edge of the watch and bezel surround, polished metal crown winder and

mineral glass. - Blued steel diamond-shaped hands for the hours and minutes. - Matte gold-colored metal dial marked JUST painted in black, Arabic numerals for the hours with a railroad graduation for the minutes painted in black. - Small seconds dial at six o'clock with a railroad graduation painted in black for the seconds and steel second hand. - Gilded brass movement signed in hollow in an oval JUST and set with rubies with anchor escapement, screws, crown, polished steel crown wheel, advance and delay racket located above the balance wheel. - Pendant winder and time setting by pulling on the top of the winder crown while turning clockwise. - In perfect working order, revised by a watchmaker. - Art Deco period, 20th century, circa 1920-1930. Gross weight: 79,15 gr.
