Beautiful Buddha head; the headdress is decorated with the Ushnisha in a high flamed spiral, 32nd attribute, symbol of Enlightenment and the spiritual power of the founder of Buddhism. Bronze with medal patina on a wooden base. Burma, late 19th / early 20th century. Please note: this head is in very good general condition. Traces of oxidation on the back - visible in photos. Beautiful quality of execution, especially of the headdress. Please look carefully at the photos.
