ANGLADE, GASTON Bordeaux 1854-1919 He is like Didier-Pouget (who sued him for counterfeiting) attracted by the mauve tones of the heather in the landscapes of Charentes; but this student of Pelouse puts more personality into his paintings than his rival. Happy effects of light illuminate his views of Bordeaux and the suburbs of Paris most often treated in watercolor. This is the best part of his work.
