Dimensions: Case: 24 x 12 x 17 cm | Camera: 22 x 15 x 4 cm The "Ica Folding Reflex" or "Ica - Klappreflex -Künstler - Camera" camera manufactured by Ica (Zeiss Icon) AG (International Camera Aktien Gesellschaft) of Dresden, Germany, circa 1922, was designed for artist photographers as a very compact and very robust reflex camera that could be folded into a very flat format.
