This handsome Art Deco sterling silver whisky hip flask was crafted by the renowned Robert Pringle & Sons and assayed at the Chester office in 1927, a significant centre of English provincial silver production. The flask features a classic square design with a slightly curved body and rounded edges, perfectly combining style and practicality.

Executed in fine sterling silver, the flask has a beautifully smooth polished surface. The wide, curved form was designed for comfortable carrying in a jacket or vest pocket, while the sturdy hinged bayonet cap screws tightly to prevent spillage -- ideal for discreetly carrying whisky, brandy, or other spirits while travelling,
