Fully restored Art Deco Sideboard or Buffet in Macassar ebony veneer and brass, from Paris, France around 1930.Manufacturer: Georges & Gaston Guerin, Paris (signed)Macassar ebony veneer, lacquered with piano lacquer and high-gloss polished. Doors counter-veneered inside in rosewood and high-gloss lacquered. Two curved smaller doors on the sides, 2 doors in the middle. Original polished brass trims, key bushes, hinges and original keys. At the front center is a curved typical Art Deco brass ornament, divided over both doors. The shape of the legs and ornament suggest that the sideboard could have been designed by Jules Leleu. The manufacturer is "Ameublement Georges & Gaston Guerin Fabricants, Paris" (signed on the inside drawer with the manufacturer's
