This exceptional ormolu 'bull' mantel clock is a distinguished piece dating from around 1830. The clock features a finely detailed bull figure supporting an elegant rectangular base decorated with an ogee profile and ornamental garlands. The enamel dial is meticulously crafted and bears the signature of J. Mansfield, London. The movement is fully functional, ensuring that its charm is matched by its practicality. Provenance of J. Mansfield Joseph Mansfield, a renowned clockmaker of Shaftesbury, Dorset, was born in 1814. Probably the son of Thomas Mansfield, who had established his business in Salisbury Street around 1780, Joseph Mansfield continued the family tradition, first recorded in High Street in 1842 and then in Salisbury Street in 1867.
