Historical context: The original altarpiece, made during the reign of King Sancho VI the Wise in the late 12th century, is attributed to a French workshop in Limoges and is kept in the Sanctuary of San Miguel de Aralar in Spain. Materials and craftsmanship: Materials: Made of gilded bronze, enamelled and inlaid with semi-precious stones, including turquoise, malachite, citrine and agate.
