

It was created in 1927 by Albert Gleizes and Juliette Roche. The young artist couple Claude Famechon and Michel Carlin, moved to Moly Sabata in 1968 at the request of Juliette Roche-Gleizes. They undertook the restoration of a dilapidated house and devoted themselves to painting and pottery.
