

After his first solo exhibition in Budapest in 1943, he moved to Paris, where he exhibited regularly in several salons, including the Salon d'Automne and the Salon de Comparison. An active member of several Parisian artistic groups, Simonka exhibited successfully throughout Europe and his works are in the permanent collections of many European museums, including that of the Centre Pompidou
