One high, one low, (more marked by humidity), each forged, with differences in size, saw cutting and engraving, frame in rope lines of the floral decoration. The large hinges, (internal diameter 15mm) testify to thickness of this door. Superb forging work, artistic and indestructible, 17th century, the pomegranate decoration was fashionable...
