In short, this beautiful object is a tall box hidden in the architecture of a tall chatelet with four hexagonal turrets in the corners with pointed roofs like the central dwelling decorated with port windows and balconies in large numbers giving it its proud appearance, the pyramid roof (lid) covering the small chateau itself decorated with three generous "dog sitting" windows, the tops topped with a
