Emile NOIROT was born in Roanne in 1853 and died in 1924 in Saint-Germain-des-Fossés. Following in his father's footsteps, Emile Noirot surpassed his master and his fame. Painter for the Ministry of the Navy, out of competition at the salon of the Society of French Artists, Emile was a great traveler while prioritizing his family ties. Although he travelled the coasts of the Channel,
