



## Large Italian Reliquary - 17th Century



## Description

Our reliquary is made of carved wood, beautifully polychromed and gilded. Probably Italian work from the end of the 17th century.

Decorated with two symmetrical cherubs carrying the martyr's palm and a crown at the top, it accommodates two reliquary niches, one in the shape of a heart decorated with four red hearts and the other oval surrounded by a braided crown and enriched with twelve blue stars.

The image of the twelve stars, announcing the Virgin, is directly inspired by the Apocalypse of Saint John (12.1): "A great sign appeared in the sky: a woman, clothed with the sun, the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head."

Red hearts are often associated with Christ, symbol of his infinite love and his passion. Here,
