A pair of armchairs, 19th century, Louis XV style, circa 1860, fine Louis XV style armchairs with wavy and profiled structural forms, upholstered on the seat, back and armrests, supported on four legs, the front and rear two cabriole legs with tapered ends, The backs are slightly inclined towards the rear, their shape is similar to that of a rectangle, with carvings in the finial in the form of shells and acanthus leaves. The seats are wider at the front, with a rounded frame on the sides, profiled at the front and secured by spring belts at the bottom. The handrails are carved, curved outwards, slightly set back from the front frame. Gilded beech frame, rich wood carving. Insurrection: France, 2nd half of the 19th century Condition: very good, one back has a tear of about 2 millimeters
