The palmettes organized around the central diamond on a finely openwork volume contribute to the Art Deco aesthetic of the jewel. The pearl finish of the settings is just as representative and brings refinement to this ring. This beautiful volume, very ergonomic by its shape, is easy to wear in all circumstances.
