Description

This type of crucifix was created in large quantities for Vietnamese, Chinese and other Christians. The shape and decorations are always similar and the mother-of-pearl patterns are inlaid in a beautiful rosewood. These are usually Vietnamese creations. The crucifix presented here is carved in a different wood which seems to us to be rosewood, Chinese Huang-Hualy, which allows us to think that it was created in the south of China, perhaps in Macao and not in Vietnam, which is much rarer. A few years ago, in a period of great euphoria, a similar crucifix, carved in the same wood was sold by a famous auction house for EUR28,000. We will find the documentation if necessary. However, there are also Vietnamese crucifixes of excellent quality but always on rosewood.
