Pin in 750/°° (18 KT) yellow gold from the Art Nouveau period. Very representative of this movement, it takes up all of its components: the curves, in its general form as in the interior patterns, caused by the floral and plant theme.....Its workmanship, also, refers us to Art Nouveau jewelry, particularly by the use of enamel, here applied using the plique à jour technique, in transparency, which constitutes and remains a performance today....and its subtle color varying around green, sometimes in celadon tones. The work of texture and sculpture gives realism to this floral ensemble whose flower is adorned with an old-cut diamond in its center. The pin is made of metal, which is a guarantee of increased solidity in the handling and wearing of this jewel. Old cut diamond weight estimated at
