Oil on canvas signed lower left Henri Pontoy. This vibrant and luminous painting by Henri Pontoy captures a lively scene in a Moroccan souk. The artist, known for his exotic representations and his travels in North Africa, depicts here an authentic and colorful atmosphere, typical of traditional markets. The play of shadows and lights, projected by the trellises above the souk, accentuate the depth and energy of the composition. We can distinguish characters dressed in djellabas blending into a decor rich in details: a donkey loaded with goods, stalls, and floral touches evoking daily life.
