author of the book Emile LOUBON born in Aix en Provence in 1809 died in Marseille in 1863 Pupil of Constantin and Granet with whom he spent two years in Rome. He had a studio in Paris from 1831 to 1845 He exhibited at the Salon from 1833 An innovative artist, he is considered the leader of the Provençal school and one of the creators of the animated landscape, marked by the swarming of men and animals In 1845 he was appointed director of the Marseille drawing school His works appear in various museums free shipping worldwide
