Handwritten bookplate by Louis Bernard. Louis Bernard bought this work in 1632, he paid 6 pounds for it. Louis Bernard wrote several texts on the blank pages about his love of God. I quote the text on the first blank page: "Farewell, fickle sex, I have left your empire, I have recognized the harm that is done by serving you, you have favored those whom you should destroy and you have destroyed
