



Rare Pewter Wine Pitcher - Buxeuil (vienne), 18th Century



Description

Very rare pewter PITCHER with a shoulder shape, flared foot and "postillon's boot" goblet with a recessed lid and acorn thumb.Hallmark of François BRION, master around 1700, died after 1721: crowned hammer / F.B.R.Height: 20.3 cm.BUXEUIL (Vienne), first half of the 18th centuryVery good condition and of good quality of material, a scratch is however indicated by an arrow on one of the shotsUnpublished hallmark which cannot be attributed to any other master of the Orléans region, the only French region to have adopted this type of shape observed in CHARTRES, CHÂTEAUDUN, MONTARGIS, MONTEREAU, ORLEANS...The initials F.B of the master are in fact arranged horizontally, the R of a smaller size, below the two main ones. This arrangement has sometimes been used to
