Table lamp in stone inlay (travertine) and brass fillet inlay, designed by Maitland Smith in the USA in the 1970s.

The lamp is made from tessellated stone, a technique in which small pieces of stone are assembled in a mosaic pattern. The brass fillet inlays create graphic contours that accentuate its interesting, geometric and flared design. This lamp is in the Hollywood Regency style of the 1970s, reminiscent of the 'Gatsby' style of the Art Deco period of the 1930s.
