About the artist: Jacques Michel, born in 1936 and died in 2020, marked the history of Belgian jewelry with his bold and timeless creations. A graduate of the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Brussels, he worked on prestigious projects, including the decoration of the textile pavilion at Expo 58 in Brussels. He also worked as a costume designer for theatre and television before devoting himself to the creation of precious jewellery from 1969. His works, often unique, are exhibited in prestigious collections, notably at the Veranneman Foundation in Kruishoutem. Style and period: This pendant, dated 1969, bears witness to Jacques Michel's avant-garde and refined aesthetic at the end of the 1960s. The 18-carat gold setting, combined with natural black opals, reflects his taste for precious materials and his talent for innovative design.
