A student of the painter Albert Maignan in Paris, Paul Pascal exhibited at the Salon des artistes français from 1894, and became a member. In love with Brittany, he produced many landscapes and genre scenes, mainly Cornish subjects: Douarnenez, Concarneau, Pont-Aven, Morgat, Sainte-Anne-La-Palud.
