The side parts with finely guilloched ogee with geometric motifs in relief, the reverse decorated with a rocaille shell recall the marine theme of the box An object of virtue This snuff box perfectly embodies the precious object that any wealthy person had to possess. Rich in its decoration, it is an object of exquisite refinement.
