



Art Nouveau Dragonfly Milk Jug Luneville Earthenware 19th Century



Description

Art Nouveau milk jug, creamer in Luneville earthenware according to the marks on the underside indicating: K&G Luneville, dating from the end of the 19th century. This mark was registered at the Paris office 39 rue de Paradis-Poissonière between 1879 and 1889. It is decorated with irises, delicate flowers and light colors.

The handle is formed by a dragonfly with widely spread wings.

The varnish of the entire surface is slightly iridescent and quite clearly cracked on the entire pot inside and out.

The top of the outer neck and the base are decorated with pale green and surrounded by gold.
