From 1932 to 1935, he traveled to Tahiti and New York where he settled to pursue his art. In 1936, the Wildenstein Gallery in New York organized his first solo exhibition. As for the condition, we note that the frame is a little damaged, pitted and stained, especially in the Marie-Louise. However, the work is in good condition.
