



Belle Epoque Style Marquise Ring Pink Tourmaline Emerald Cut & Diamonds / Rose And White Gold

Marquise ring, in 750/°° pink and white gold (18 KT, owl hallmark) in the turn of the century style, decorated in its center with a luminous pink tourmaline with a slightly mauve color. This stone with its rich material is rare on this type of ring, and its rectangular emerald cut with cut sides adds to the singularity of this jewel. It is surrounded by old-cut diamonds set closed on several levels giving it a dynamic aesthetic. This set is evocative of a turn of the century ring, while the body made of multiple pink gold wires evokes a manufacture from the 50s....and gives volume to the whole, as well as stability on the finger to this ring of beautiful size.
