Ring in 750/°° white gold (18 KT, owl hallmark) exclusively decorated with diamonds. In the center, three old-cut diamonds form a garter; cut on a general linear volume in a band, also set with brilliant-cut diamonds. This linear and openwork arrangement, with a shoulder cut in steps, gives this jewel an Art Deco aesthetic, as well as the general white color produced by the white gold and the diamonds. The old-cut diamonds also contribute to the Art Deco aesthetic since they were set at the time, just like here, as center stones. Total weight of diamonds estimated at approximately 2.06 carats, including a central old-cut diamond of 0.60 carats, supported by two old-cut diamonds of 0.30 carats each Gross weight: 10.03 g Ring size: 47 and a half - possible resizing to be assessed by our workshop (current
