BEAUTIFUL AND INTERESTING VEGETABLE DISH IN MARSEILLE ROBERT EARTHENWARE FROM THE 18TH CENTURY, THE NUMBER 5 INCISED UNDER THE LID AND THE BASE ITSELF MARKED WITH A GREEN DOT; THE LID HAS REMARKABLE PICNIC SCENES, TESTIMONY OF THE TABLE ARTS OF THE TIME. WE CAN SEE GLASS BOTTLES AND THEIR LABELS, PITCHERS PROBABLY IN SILVER-GILT AS WELL AS A LARGE BLUE ENAMEL EARTHENWARE DISH, THE OTHER SIDE WITH A BASKET OF FISH AND FRUIT. THE LID AND THE BASE ARE BROKEN IN THREE AND RESTORED, ONLY THE WHITE ENAMEL HAS BEEN REVARNISHED EXCLUDING THE
