



Sculpture "piéta" From 1999 In Belgian Black Marble By The Belgian Sculptor Pol Spilliaert



Description

Large sculpture "Piéta" from 1999 in Belgian black marble by the Belgian sculptor Pol Spilliaert (1935-2023). This sculpture reflects the artist's characteristic style by combining organic and geometric forms, creating an interesting sense of tension. Pol Spilliaert studied sculpture at the Academy of Fine Arts of La Cambre in Brussels, where he was taught by figures such as the modernist architect Leon Stynen, from whom he graduated in 1959. This sculpture is accompanied by a photo of Pol Spilliaert posing near his work and a photocopy of a handwritten letter from the artist to the first owner of the work explaining the approach and meaning of this sculpture.
