Rare office chair in mahogany and mahogany veneer. It rests on 4 Etruscan sabre legs, the backrest with scrolls, the armrests with balls. Our chair is richly covered with horsehair. End of the Empire period, early 19th century, 1810s. Stamp of Jacob Desmalter et Cie JACOB. DR MESLEE. used between 1803 and 1813. The seat bears a trace of a handwritten chateau label underneath (disappeared) The Jacob dynasty is probably the most prestigious of French carpenters and cabinetmakers of the late 18th century and early 19th century, with immense success as a supplier in particular to the Imperial Furniture Store (as well as that of the Crown before and after the Empire). The seats produced by Jacob's workshop are recognizable, in particular, by the very high quality of their execution, the always perfect
