Support: Perpetual calendar composed of three cardboard discs -First disc: sign of the planets, sign of the zodiac, length of Days and Nights, sunrise and sunset -Second disc: the year - Third disc: the days -Engraving from 1816. History: In 1793, Louis XVI was guillotined with his wife Marie-Antoinette - 1816 was a year that was part of the Restoration in France - 19th century. Description: King Louis XVIII (Louis Stanislas Xavier of France, Count of Provence) is depicted with his family (including Charles-Ferdinand d'Artois, Duke of Berry, Louis-Antoine d'Artois, Duke of Angoulême, named Louis of France, and Count d'Artois, Charles-Philippe of France) - The woman is the Duchess of Angoulême - The calendar is very illustrated: angels, crowns,
