Description

Painting depicting a street in southern Spain, probably in or around Seville; A man and a woman are about to cross paths on a street lined with a fence. In the foreground, a cart pulled by a mule enters the left field. In the background, buildings with flat roofs seem crushed by the heat. Tree trunks and electricity poles cross the scene from top to bottom.

The framing and subject are original. The artist proceeded by flats, covering and covering the surfaces.

The work is signed and dated 1929 at the bottom right. It is in good condition, although slightly expanded (traces of the frame at the top). It is offered in a sober varnished wooden frame, in fair condition.
