Description

Lovely pair of Louis XVI style candelabra mounted as a lamp. On a square white marble base, the spiral marble baluster shaft in the shape of a vase, with application of gilded bronze flower falls on the shoulder. From the crown of the vase, 5 gilded bronze light arms in the shape of rose branches with leaves, buds and soon in the shape of a blooming rose. Original gilding present, but stained in places. These candelabra were mounted electrically, and are working. The spirals on the marble shafts are reversed, this is a real pendant pair. Particularly decorative objects, from the late 19th century but in the quality of 18th century works. Some micro chips to the marble, stained and faded gilding in places. 19th century period around 1890. Delivery by carrier, 100 euros in France, 200 euros in the EU and 600
