Description

The dazzling light of midday, a perfect mastery of colors, all the charm and atmosphere of the landscapes of Provence at the beginning of the 20th century for this charming oil on canvas by the Avignon painter Eugène Marius Yvan.

The work is done in oil on canvas, it is offered in a simple frame with white patina (typical of the 50s) which measures 68 cm by 86 cm and 54 cm by 73 cm for the canvas alone.

It represents a village street flooded with sunlight, where the vines cling to the old stones, and animated by a character who carries a jug and a hen. In good condition, the work is signed and dated 1922 at the bottom left.
