Bronze bust depicting Georges Cuvier 1769-1832. Georges Cuvier is one of the great scientists of his time, he is the founder of paleontology, the study of fossils. He is a notable scientific supporter of catastrophism, a precursor theory of evolution. Here our bronze is the resumption of the marble of Pierre-Jean David D'Angers located in the Puget courtyard (in the upper part). See photo twelve. Note that it bears the number 79.
