Charles-François Daubigny (1817-1878)

French landscape painter and one of the early

proponents of plein air painting in France. He came from a family of artists and was initially trained by his father, Edmé-François (1789-1843), who was also a landscape painter; he also learned much by copying 17th-century Dutch paintings at the Louvre. Although considered a member of the Barbizon school, he never resided in the village, and his preferred subjects were river scenes rather than forests (he often painted from a specially equipped boat). His work, notable for the sensitivity with which he depicted the effects of light on trees and water, had a significant influence on early Impressionism.
