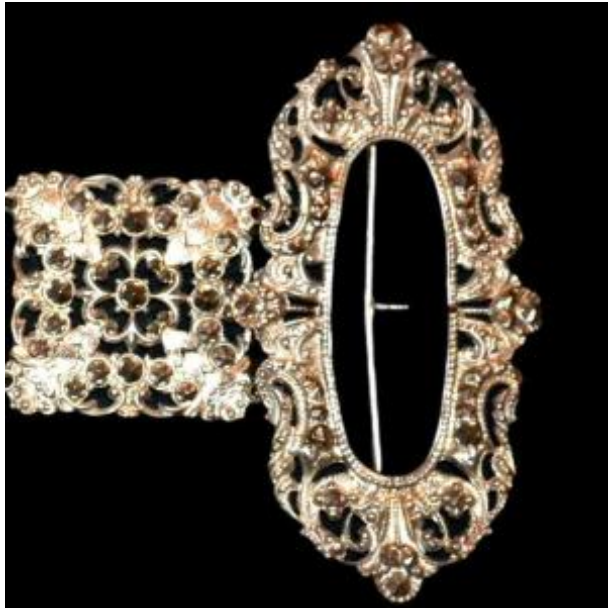




Complete Bridal Belt, Silver, Ottoman Empire Circa 1900 - 1920, Very Good Condition

Description

Filigree bridal belt circa 1900 - 1920, in cut silver (low title).

The belt consists of a superb buckle 10.3 cm high, 14 very ornate square links, foliated and pierced 4.5 cm wide x 4.5 cm high connected together by two fasteners.

- The second link has two protrusions used to block the belt loop.
- The last link cut at an angle, finishes the belt.
- On the eleventh link, a small discreet buckle, was used to put a stitch so that the belt does not turn

The belt measures 76 cm long for a total weight of 174 grs.

Worn on the kaftan during the wedding.

The set is complete, buckle, belt loop, fastener, links and in very good condition.
