Porcelain water pot with blue and white Lotus flower decoration, for the Vietnamese or Thai market.

This model would have been made after more rustic stoneware models, used to serve rice or tea. China 16th/17th century Transitional / Kangxi period (1661-1722)

The lid is missing, the handle has been restored at several points, as have the two ends, which have been broken off and glued back together, and there is some evidence of repainting in these areas. Some firing defects, chips, lines in the glaze. Some very short lines as well.
