## Description

Large and unique Obelisk, called of the sea because all the elements that compose it are the fruit of his work, magnified by an Artist of the 20th, composed of different marbles red veined gray veined and white of Carrara and decorated with small stones rolled by the waves, white coral pearls of shells with beautiful electric blue reflections and topped with a magnificent fossil of Nautilus with its mother-of-pearl. On the two sides of the obelisk there is a medallion of straw yellow terracotta a head of Medusa symbolizing the seabed; the alternation of red marble and crushed coral rolled by the sea, patinated and in bands equally distributed on the shaft, the seat of the obelisk on its four feet in a pile of small pebbles and shells, the massive base on its base of veined gray marble alternating with false grooves
