Description

This bronze with a brown patina entitled "La Femme au Faon", monogrammed and signed by the Primavera workshop, is an emblematic work of the 1930s. The Primavera workshop, founded by Pierre Laguionie (1884-1978), director of Printemps and the lawyer René Guilleré (1878-1931), founder of the Salon des artistes décoratifs, had the mission of offering art objects at affordable prices in the eponymous stores. This figurative sculpture represents a woman letting herself be cuddled by a fawn. The artist's work is striking, with meticulous attention to detail that brings the scene to life. The brown patina of the bronze adds depth and warmth to the work, accentuating the curves and reliefs of the sculpture. The soft and peaceful expression of the woman, combined with the tenderness of the
