This experience would influence his creations. He retained an aesthetic interest in geometric shapes and precision. 1920, back in Avallon, he set up his workshop in 1924 and produced goldwork and jewelry pieces which he exhibited in the boutique at 20 place Vauban and in numerous trade fairs.
